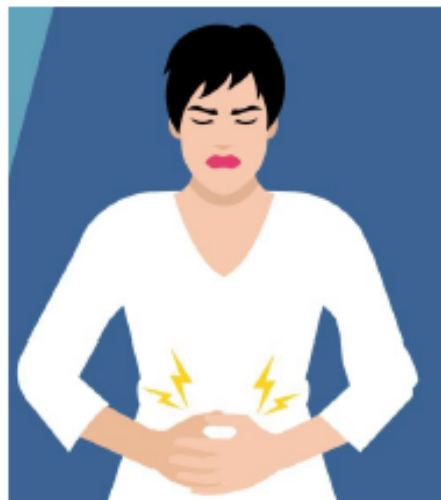


Do You Have SIBO?

What is SIBO?

SIBO occurs when there are excess bacteria in the small intestine. The symptoms of SIBO include:

- bloating and increased passing of gas (flatulence)
- constipation
- abdominal pain
- nausea
- belching or burping
